Garden Waste Permit 2021/22

Garden waste permits are now available to be purchased for 2021/22. The easy way to pay for a garden waste permit is online by visiting www.pkc.gov.uk/gardenwaste.

Should you wish to recycle items other than food, such as garden waste, cut flowers and sawdust, you will need to display a valid 2021/22 garden waste permit on your brown bin(s) from **Thursday 1 April 2021**. The 2021/22 Garden Waste Permit is valid from 1 April 2021 to 31 March 2022 and the cost is £40 per bin – householders can have a maximum of 2 brown bins per property.

All residents should use their brown bin to recycle any household food waste. A permit is NOT required for recycling food waste.

Purchasing a permit before **Monday 1 March 2021** will ensure you don't miss any collections as after this date, we cannot guarantee you will have the permit in time for the new service start date.

Residents who are unable to pay online but wish to use a debit or credit card should call the Council's Customer Service Centre on 01738 476476 for assistance.

Residents who have an Assisted Lift service for their brown bin(s) will continue to receive the service and can recycle garden waste if a valid permit is displayed on the bin(s).
