- 3. Minute of meeting 14th February 2020. Approved.

4. Matters Arising

- i. Item 4 (May 19) NC meeting with PKC Planning & Andy Clegg (PKC Greenspace took place March 2020. NC made the point about early input. The issue is now shelved until post covid.
- ii. Item 5 (Nov 19). The site meeting at Dunira is still to be arranged. SS and HA to follow up when this is possible.
- iii. Item 13ii (Nov 19) SS's planned tree felling is on hold pending consultation. Timber extraction may raise access issues.
- iv. Item 8i (Feb 20) National Access Forum NAF/LAF March meeting cancelled. Subsequent NAF meeting poorly attended. Next one is planned for September and will be held online.
- v. Item 10i (Feb 20) NC asked PKC to reconsider its position re the closed pat ha the Hermitage.
- vi. Item 11ii (Feb 20) CILPK representation. NC to write to BB and Gillian Edwards about future attendance and representation. NB. AB has practical experience of disability access issues through a close family member.

5. Exemptions and Obstructions Report

- The July report was presented, and it was agreed that the issues listed could be closed on the recommendation of the sub-group subject to the changes and clarifications listed below.
- ii. Issue 1. CAMS 01950. ABNY/115. Grid reference listed incorrectly in report. Should be NO203157. NB. JA's ongoing concern about arranged access solution to this one.

- iii. Issue 20. CAMS 1945. Dalmunzie has been resolved and could now be closed.
- iv. Issue 25. CAMS 1941. Redmyre. Appears to be a repeat of previously reported issue and could now be closed.
- v. Issue 38. CAMS 1810. FSWY/134. If no agreement possible PKC to consider s.19 action.
- vi. Issue 62. CAMS 1952. Hattonburn not to close. The sign at the road end is gone, but the field margin is still difficult to use, and a further sign remains at the farm end.
- vii. Issue 37. FSWY/134. If owners will not agree to the opening up a diversion s.19 should be used to re-establish access along the core path itself.
- viii. Issue not listed. MTHT/139 to add to the list. Core path has been ploughed up.
- ix. Issue 44. CAMS 1861 RANN/112. S/C gate installed by paths group with agreement of LM. Issue can now be closed. (post meeting note, see BBC landward)
- x. Action JP to circulate list of core paths for possible review. Forum may want to write in support of expediting the CPP review.
