How would you use £500?

Strathtay Action Partnership has £5,000 funding to distribute to local groups as small grants. The Strathtay Micro Grant Funding will support projects that are run by and for the people of Strathtay. The purpose of the funding is to achieve a positive impact on the lives of people in the area.

What is Micro Grant Funding?

The funding offers a chance for local groups to run a project or fund an activity which benefits the people of Strathtay.

- Your bid should be a maximum of £500
- It should link to one of the following themes –
 - Poverty (Child, Food and Fuel Poverty)
 - Physical and Mental Wellbeing
 - Skills, Learning and Development
 - Employability
 - Digital Participation
- Applications can be for a one-off activity or a programme of activities which should be delivered within three months of the start of the project.
- A typical application might include: the purchase of equipment or programme materials, promotional material, venue hire, instructor costs for a particular activity.
