7 minute briefing Adult Protection – Professional Curiosity



Learning Summary: Professional curiosity has been a recurring theme in Initial Case Reviews (ICRs) and Significant Case Reviews (SCRs) over many years. Learning from ICRs and SCRs, both nationally and locally, identifies that recognising and responding to presenting issues in isolation and with a lack of professional curiosity can lead to missed opportunities to intervene, to identify less obvious indicators of vulnerability or significant harm, and we know that in the worst circumstances this has resulted in death or significant harm and abuse.
