

#### APPLICATION FOR LANDLORD REGISTRATION

You can use this form to apply for a new registration or renew an existing registration as a landlord or a non-commercial agent with Perth & Kinross Council.

You can also apply online at <a href="https://www.landlordregistrationscotland.gov.uk/">https://www.landlordregistrationscotland.gov.uk/</a>. You can use the online application system to register in several local authorities in one application and this will reduce the total fee that you will have to pay (see the accompanying notes for details on fees). Please read the accompanying guidance notes carefully before submitting your application. These notes will also tell you how to make payment.

#### **Current fees**

The fee to register is £80.00 and the charge per property is £18.00 so if you let one property the amount due will be £98.00. A charge of £18.00 applies to <u>each</u> property you let.

The lead owner will pay the appropriate registration and property fees, applications from the other joint owners are typically free of charge.

- Registration Fee: £80.00
  - Where a landlord lets property in more than one local authority area and uses the online application process this fee is discounted to £40.00
- Property Fee: £18.00 per let property
- Late Application Fee: £160.00

Houses in Multiple Occupation (HMO) will typically attract a 100% discount on the principal and property fee, but only for the property that is covered by the HMO licence (additional non-HMO properties will be charged).

Registered Scottish Charities attract 100% discount.
