Next Steps

Your views are important and will help to inform the final outline design of the flood scheme.

The Council will collect any questions and feedback provided by you and will respond in the form of a community consultation report. This report will be published and demonstrate how your views have been taken into account in the final proposals.

We will issue a further newsletter once the community consultation report and final proposals are available. The Council will then seek to publish the final proposals under the Flood Risk Management (Scotland) Act 2009.

It is important to note that the implementation of a scheme is still likely to be some time away and is not yet certain, due to the need to secure statutory consents and other approvals.

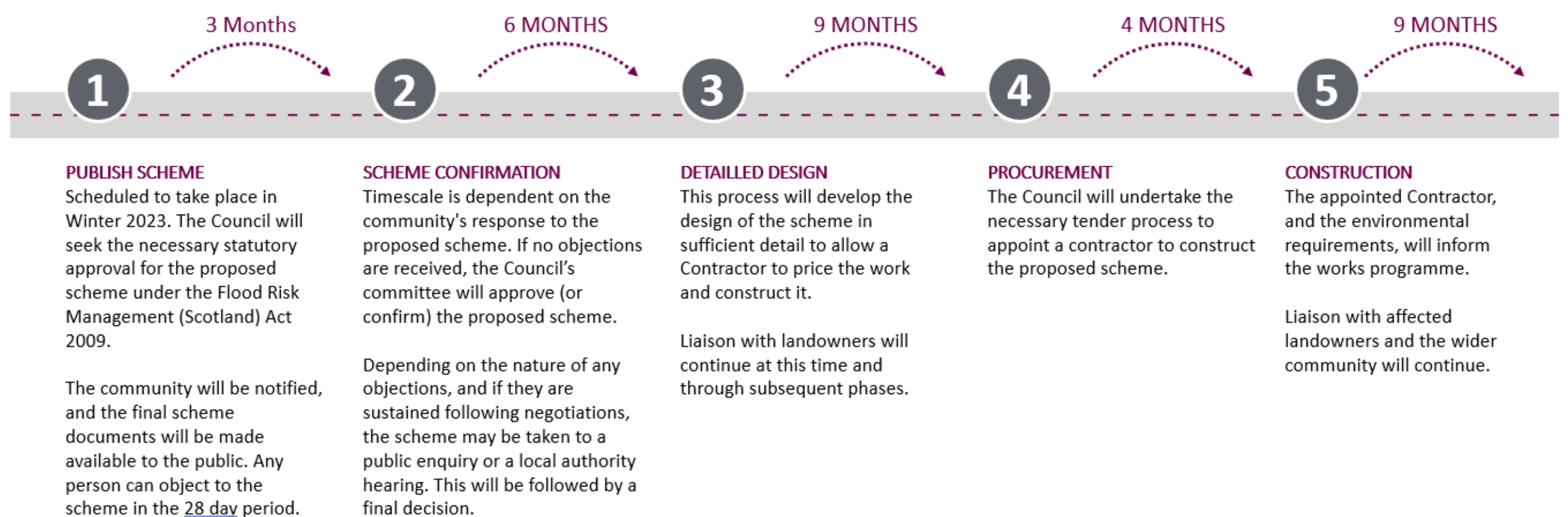


Figure 23 – Indicative Timeline

Figure 23 shows the indicative timeline for the work that still needs to be done before construction of the flood scheme can commence.

Other Action on Flood Risk

Under the Flood Risk Management (Scotland) Act 2009, Kinross has been identified as a Potential Vulnerable Area (reference 02/10/03) within the Forth Estuary Local Plan District. Actions to manage flood risk are contained within the published Forth Estuary Local Flood Risk Management Plan, and this includes the requirement for a flood protection scheme. The Council engaged consulting engineers, RPS, to deliver the flood protection scheme.

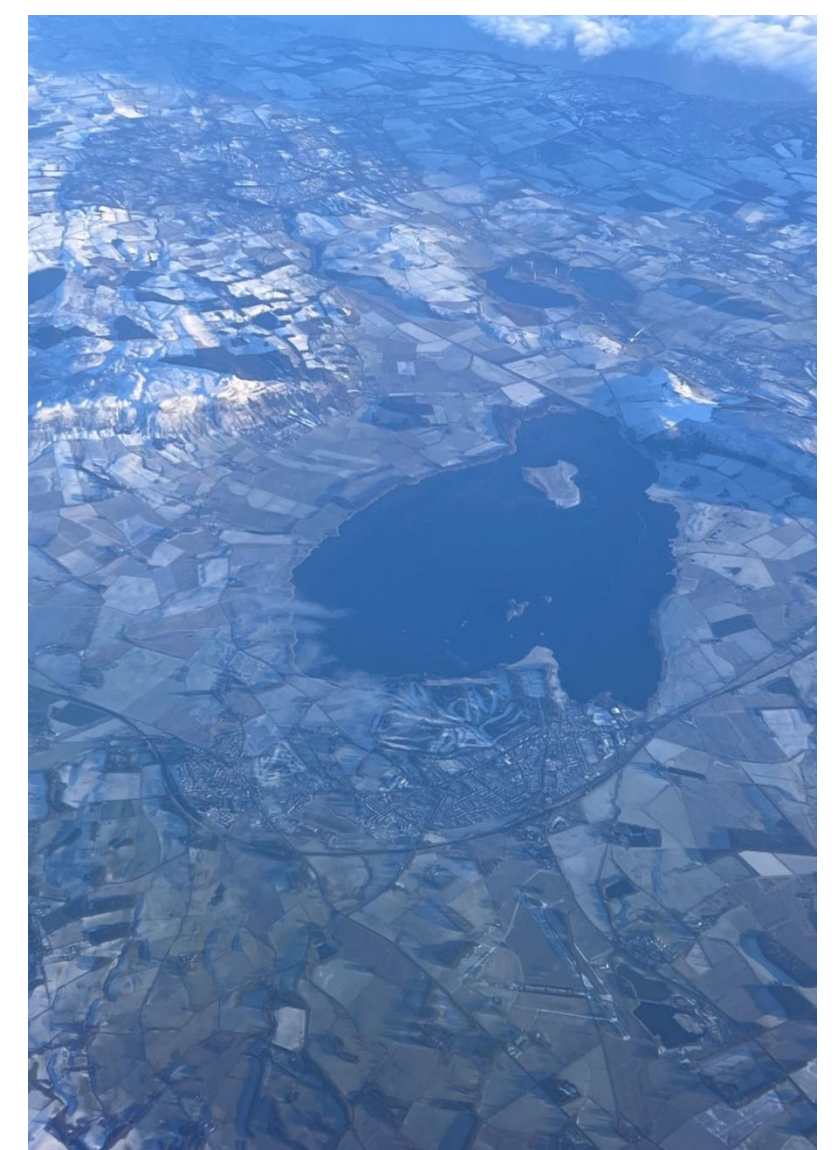


Figure 24 - Aerial View of the Scheme Area
