

## Useful Information

### Cashless Parking

Cashless Parking is available through our service provider RingGo and is available at all locations, excluding Canal Street Multi-Storey Car Park.

To use the service, download the app from your Apple or Android device's app store or visit [www.myringgo.com/bookparking](http://www.myringgo.com/bookparking)



### 15 Minutes Free

All 3 zones allow 15 minutes of free parking in Pay & Display bays. A valid ticket must be displayed and can be acquired free of charge by pressing the button on the ticket machine.

For Canal Street Multi-Storey Car Park, which is a pay-on-foot car park, present your ticket at the exit barrier up to 15 minutes after entry. Please do not present your ticket at the paystation if your length of stay is 15 minutes or less, as this may charge you for up to one hour of parking.

Only one free 15-minute ticket can be obtained per parking period - failure to comply may result in a PCN being issued to your vehicle.

### Season Tickets

### Blue Badge Holders



Blue Badge holders are allowed to park in any disabled bay or Pay & Display bay on-street or in a Council car park free of charge and without time limit. Visitors with badges from outside the UK should contact Parking Services to register their badge. Badges are only valid if they are in date and being used for the benefit of the badge holder.

### Payment Methods

All Pay & Display machines and Pay Stations accept coins. Contactless payments are available at South Street, Blackwatch Gardens, Foundry Lane, Kinnoull Street, Victoria Street, King Street, Princes Street, Scott Street, Scott Street car park, South Inch car park, Speygate car park and Thimble Row car park. Chip and pin payments are also available at Canal Street Multi-Storey.

### Motorcycle Parking

Motorcycles can park free of charge in any on or off street Council Pay & Display bay. Dedicated motorcycle bays can be found in Canal Street Multi-Storey, Scott Street car park and on Scott Street.

### Park & Ride in Perth City

There are two Park & Ride sites operating in Perth - one at Broxden and the other at Scone - providing convenient parking next to the departure points for buses into the city centre and express coaches serving other Scottish cities.

### Motorhome Parking

Dedicated parking for motorhomes can be found at Broxden Park & Ride, where waste facilities are also provided.

### Coach Parking

Coach drop off and pick up bays can be found on Bridge Lane, George Street, South Street, Tay Street and Glover Street (Leisure Pool). Dedicated coach parking bays are available in South Inch Car Park.

# Perth Parking Guide



# Parking in Perth City

Parking in Perth City is divided up into three zones.

## Zone 1

Zone 1 encompasses all Council on and off-street parking bordered by Mill Street, South Methven Street, Canal Street and Tay Street (north of Queen's Bridge).

On-street parking is limited to 1 hour at a flat rate of £1.80 per hour and off-street parking is limited to 1 hour at a flat rate of £1.60.

Parking for up to 4 hours at a flat rate of £1.60 per hour is available at Scott Street car park.

All day parking is available at Canal Steet Multi-Storey car park. 1 hour is £1.60, 2 hours is £3.10, 3 hours is £4.80, 4 hours is £6.20, 6 hours is £9.60 and up to 10 hours is £12.80. Season Tickets can also be purchased.

## Zone 2

Zone 2 is bordered by Tay Street (south of Queen's Bridge), Marshall Place, Caledonian Road, Atholl Street and includes Back Wynd car park in Bridgend.

Parking is for a maximum of 4 hours at a flat rate of £1.80 per hour on-street and £1.60 per hour off-street.

## Zone 3

Zone 3 encompasses the South Inch car park and the on-street parking on Shore Road, Edinburgh Road, St Leonard's Bank, the east bank of the Tay with Norrie Miller and Riverside Turning Head car parks.

Parking on-street is for a maximum of 10 hours and costs £1.20 for 1 hour, £1.80 for 2 hours, £2.70 for 3 hours, £3.40 for 4 hours, £5.20 for 6 hours and £7.00 for 10 hours.

Parking off-street is for a maximum of 10 hours and costs £1.10 for 1 hour, £1.60 for 2 hours, £2.50 for 3 hours, £3.10 for 4 hours, £4.80 for 6 hours and £6.20 for 10 hours.
