I would like to reiterate all of the arguments set out in the original objection but would note in particular that the decision referenced that our privacy at Garth House was protected by the presence of mature trees. We acknowledge that there is cover in summer, but as highlighted previously, the trees are deciduous and for 7 months of the year, there would be a clear view from the pod into our garden given the pod's elevated position, thereby impacting our privacy and right to enjoy the garden.
