

TAYMOUTH CASTLE TREE PRESERVATION ORDER (NO 1) 2025

Perth and Kinross Council as planning authority in terms of the Town and Country Planning (Scotland) Act 1997 and Town and Country Planning (Tree Preservation Order and Trees in Conservation Areas) (Scotland) Regulations 2010 have made the above Order affecting the trees therein specified.

1. The planning authority considers that the four Beech trees covered by this Order are located within the Kenmore Conservation Area and are under threat of felling. They are mature, healthy specimens, with no obvious arboricultural reason for them to be felled. The Cherry tree, although not under direct threat, is also covered by this Order, as it is considered an attractive tree of merit complimenting the four adjacent Beech trees.

The planning authority shall, before deciding whether to confirm the Order, take into consideration any representations made.
