Thank you for sending the written representation of further comments by Mr Grant, about the above appeal.

The appellants' response is:

- "Perthshire Caravans is celebrating their 90th anniversary in 2026, we have been on this site since 1936. Therefore this has been a commercial site since then. Mr Grant writes to complain that the business should not be here, or should relocate, however the fact is the business was established nearly 90 years ago on this very site and has no plans to relocate.
- We employ 100 staff, most of which live within the surrounding area. The company is therefore a significant employer but also a known brand synonymous with Perthshire (in name and in location) – to move business or relocate as suggested would take such economic benefit from Perth and Kinross Council area.
- Mr Grant lives right next to where the break in occurred, why did he not raise the alarm?

Would be pleased if LRB could take these points into account when assessing the appeal.
