**Comrie Flood Protection Scheme 2020
Flood Risk Management (Scotland) Act 2009
The Flood Risk Management (Flood Protection Schemes, Potentially Vulnerable
Areas and Local Plan Districts) (Scotland) Regulations 2010**

I refer to the Council's previous letter of 20 February 2020 notifying you of the above Scheme under the above Act and Regulations.

I am now writing to notify you that Perth and Kinross Council's Environment and Infrastructure Committee took a final decision to confirm the Comrie Flood Protection Scheme 2020 with no modifications on 18 August 2021.

The enclosed notice will be published in the Courier and Edinburgh Gazette, and displayed in a prominent position throughout Comrie on 3 September 2021. The Scheme will become operative six weeks after this date unless an appeal is made against the Scheme. Further information on making an appeal is included in the attached Notice.


If no appeal is made, then the Scheme will become operative from 15 October 2021. This does not mean that construction of the Scheme will commence immediately: simply that the Council will have the necessary statutory power to construct the Scheme when the appropriate time comes.

Work is still required to finalise the detailed design of the Scheme and construction will commence at a later stage. In the meantime, the Council will continue to keep the community informed of progress.
