



Privacy Notice – Globalbridge

Why is this information being processed?

The information provided by you and held by Perth and Kinross Council Children’s Services on SEEMiS (Education Management information system), will be used by the Council for the purpose of registering pupils for Globalbridge. Globalbridge is an online profiling tool that enables pupils to record evidence of their skills and achievements in various media formats, and view opportunities from universities and/or employers.

The personal information that will be shared with Globalbridge for this purpose includes:

Students may also share the following additional data when they use the platform:

- alternative email address (to maintain access to account when leaving educational institution)
- parental name and email address (for students to invite their parents to view their profile)
- post code (to display relevant opportunities)
- gender (to gather aggregated data relating to opportunities)
- ethnicity (to gather aggregated data relating to opportunities)
- details of industries of interest
- details of types of opportunities they are interested in (such as work experience, university courses)

- details of their education and academic performance (such as their achieved or predicted grades)
- skills (including examples of how they have developed these skills)
- experiences (such as work experience, volunteering or talks and presentations they have attended)
- talents and achievements (such as additional certifications, digital badges)
- media content (such as photos, videos, audio or documents)

Why is it lawful for the Council to process this information?

Globalbridge is not widely used across the Council. Consequently, the use of Globalbridge is not the only way in which young people can find and consider future opportunities. However, where a Headteacher has made the professional decision that the use of Globalbridge will be a benefit to the opportunities of a particular class or set of pupils within the requirements of legal teaching framework (for example CfE), it is reasonable to consider the use of Globalbridge as necessary for a task carried out in the public interest or under official authority.

Formally, the processing of personal data provided to us for this purpose satisfies Article 6(e) of the UK General Data Protection Regulation – “Processing shall be lawful...to the extent that: processing is necessary for the performance of a task carried out in the public interest or in the exercise of official authority vested in the controller”.

Will any sensitive personal information (Special Category Data or information about criminal convictions etc) be processed?

Special category data (such as ethnicity) could be processed if pupils choose to enter it.

If so, why is it lawful for the Council to process this information?

In this case the processing would be lawful under the terms of Article 9 (2)(e) of the UK GDPR, “processing relates to personal data which are manifestly made public by the data subject”

Will this information be shared?

Perth and Kinross Council will share the information listed in the table above with Globalbridge.

Your personal information will not be disclosed to other third parties unless it's necessary for us to do so in order to verify its accuracy, prevent or detect crime, protect public funds or where required by law. The Council may check information provided by you, or information about you provided by a third party, with other information held by us.

How long will this information be kept for?

Staff administrators can manually delete student profiles when students leave the school.

Students will be removed from the school system and not be visible to the school after they have left.

However, there is a possibility that pupils may continue to have access to their account after they leave school. Students will be invited by email to transfer their account to 'Bridgepro' the post-school version of Globalbridge – this will let them maintain access to their learner profile.
